PARENTAL CONSENT FORM FOR CTC CYCLING ACTIVITIES

All participants under 18 must have signed a CTC parental consent form. The only exemption is where a young person having reached the age of 16 can prove that they are no longer living with parents or guardian and is de-facto living as an independent adult. This will be proven by the supply of evidence such as a rent book or utility bill with the person's current address in their name or a National Union of Students membership card.

Events set up specifically for children do not usually have any specific age requirements, please clarify with your organiser or see details overleaf.

The minimum age for unaccompanied children is 13 on open-age CTC rides and events. There is no lower age limit if accompanied by a responsible adult acting *in loco parentis*, but a parental consent form is still needed. Children aged from 13 to 17 may participate unaccompanied in open age activities if they have parental permission to take part in an open activity but parents must understand while CTC extends a welcome to cyclists of all ages and abilities there may be no special provision for children on the activity.

Parents/ guardians must be aware of the demands of any activity, and that they alone make the decision about the ability of the child to complete the activity. They must be aware of the likelihood of the child riding alone, or with company and the arrangements for this to happen. Arrangements to get to and from the ride are wholly the responsibility of the parent/ guardian.

CTC, its members, agents and other participants may take photographs during the courser of the event, mostly for private use but some may be for local or national publicity purposes. If you do not want photographs of your child used in any publications please indicate below.

START AND FINISH AT BISHOP'S WALTHAM

Start at 9.30am.

Finish control opens at 12.30pm (3hrs. = 16mph.) closes at 2.45pm. (5.25hrs. = 9mph)

This is a route of about 48 miles. It lies on OS maps 185, 186, 197 & 196 the directions will I hope be sufficient .
(Hot food served all day from 12noon at the finish).

**Legend: R = Turn Right. L = Turn Left. SO = Straight On. T = T-Junction. O = Round-about.
Y = Road Forks. SP = Sign Post. Z = Multiple Bends.**

Distances given are believed to be correct but are not guaranteed.

START IN BISHOP'S WALTHAM SQUARE.

Leave the square by Brook Street and continue via Lower Lane to **T** with B3035 where **R**. (NO SP).

2nd. R (SP Dundridge) follow road round to left past Hampshire Bowman P.H. to top of hill where **L** and **L** again at **X** (SP Corhampton).

At staggered **X** (B3035) **R & L** continue to BEACON HILL.

Follow road **Z** past trees then **R** (NO SP). 6 miles.

At **X SO** (SP Riversdown & BROCKWOOD)

Follow road round to **R** (SP West Meon) then

L (NO SP) past BROCKLEWOOD PARK. 8.6miles.

At **X A272 SO** (SP Woodlands) (Narrow road, gravel)

At **T L** (NO SP)

At **T R** (SP Alresford & Ropley)

At **O** (A31) **2nd exit** (SP GUNDLETON) 13.3miles.

Next **R** (SP GUNDLETON).

At **T R** (SP BIGHTON)

At **X R** (SP MEDSTEAD). At **T R** (SP Alton)

Thru MEDSTEAD (Church on left, shop on R open

Sunday am.) Next **R** (SP Ropley) 18.8miles

(NOTE SP subject to misalignment)

At **X (A31) L & R** (SP Church).(Lymington Bottom)

At multipule junction follow Rd. Left (SP East Tisted)

At **T L** (SP East Tisted)

At **T (A32) L** (SP Alton) 23.6miles

Next **R** (SP Colemore)

At **T L** (SP East Tisted). Next **R** (No SP) and continue past the "Pub with No Name / White Horse".

At **X SO**. 26.6 miles.

Where Pylons cross road **SO** (SP High Cross)

then at BOWER FARM follow road sharply round to **L**.

At **T R** (SP Foxfield Green & EAST MEON).

At **X SO** (NO SP)

At staggered **X** (A272) **SO** (NO SP) 29.7miles.

At **T R** (SP EAST MEON)

L by Church (Church Street, NO SP)

Follow road thru village

Near TOP OF HILL **R**

At **X SO** (SP Hambledon)

At **X** (by "Bat & Ball" PH) **SO** (SP Denmead)

35.7miles

At **X R** (SP Forest Gate & HAMBLEDON)

(very staggered **X** just after 2nd. set of power lines)

At **T R** (SP HAMBLEDON) 39.2miles

Next **L** (SP Bury Lodge)

At **T R** (No SP). Next **L** by shop/cafe (NO SP)

(Only arrowed hill of day)

At **X SO** (SP Soberton)

then keep **L** (SP Soberton Heath)

At **T R** (SP SOBERTON)

At **WAR MEMORIAL** sharp **L** (SP B. WALTHAM)

Follow road round to right to A32.

At **X (A32) SO** (SP B. WALTHAM) 43.7miles.

At **X SO** (SP SWANMORE & BISHOP'S WALTHAM)

Thru SWANMORE to BISHOP'S WALTHAM.

At **O SO**

Next **L** past "Waltham Indian".

L into HIGH STREET just before NO ENTRY sign.

Follow thru. to the **O** with the B2177 where

3rd exit (SP WINCHESTER)

At next **O** take **3rd exit** (SP Winchester).

Finish at the **Priory P.H.** a short distance on the left.
48.2 miles.
